Course Title ETHICS: Improving Respect and Confidence in the Legal Profession

Overall Objective and Purpose

This two part video course is dedicated to improve attorneys' professionalism, integrity, civility, ethics, and image; and improve respect and confidence in the legal profession.

Subject matter and content of each video session

Ethics, Part 1 Exploring Attorney image, professionalism, integrity, civility, & ethics

Ethics, Part 2 Improving Attorney image, professionalism, integrity, civility, & ethics

These two sessions focus upon and discuss attorney image, professionalism, integrity, civility, and ethics. Attorneys will learn what conduct and attributes offend the public and which are respected by the public, and how to improve the public's perception of attorneys. Attorneys will learn which foot to put forward, and learn which 'third rails' should be avoided in order to promote respect and confidence in the legal profession.
